GENERAL ITEMS

- Financial Reports from USAW as of May 31, 2023:
 - Cash \$3,699.00 (restricted funds)
 - o Total Other Current Assets \$5,448.69 (WSO rebate receivable)
 - Total Current Assets \$9,147.69
 - Total Fixed Assets \$10,163.31 (training & event equipment)
 - Net Income \$2,163.93 (25% of which goes to Athlete Support Fund)
- Meeting minutes have been sent to USAW in a timely manner since February, but have still not been uploaded to the USAW WSO site since then.
- 2023 Scholarship Payments: \$900 total paid out to athletes
- TO Directory has been updated on nywso.com/technical officials; we have 2 new National referees and 16 new WSO referees. 150 total technical officials up from 134 at last count.

JUNE E-VOTE

- James McDermott motioned to approve & insert the minutes from the June e-vote into these meeting minutes. Jerry Dunne seconds the motion.
 - All in favor, motion passed unanimously. E-vote minutes are included at the conclusion of these meeting minutes.

ATHLETE SUPPORT/VISTAPRINT ONLINE STORE

- James presented the board with the poster that Juliana Riotto has designed to help raise funds for the NY WSO Athlete Support Fund, which kicked off a discussion about starting a VistaPrint Pro Shop for WSO fundraising purposes. All proceeds from sales would go to the ASE.
- James motioned to pay & be reimbursed \$99 for a VistaPrint Pro Shop, with all proceeds going to the ASF.
 - All in favor, motion passed.

WSO EQUIPMENT

- No update on Niagara equipment. Equipment last seen in the possession of a past Metropolitan LWC rep is considered lost. Brooklyn Training Hall set will be picked up ahead of States.
- Full inventory:
 - o full Rogue competition set in Brooklyn with Juan Blanco
 - o full Rogue competition set, including collars, in Albany with James McDermott
 - (1) pair each of 2.5kg, 5kg, 10kg, 15kg plates, Rogue 20kg Pyrros bar, and a Rogue 15kg
 Pyrros bar in Binghamton with Frank Ford
 - 10kg technique bar, 5kg technique bar, 2.5kg disc pair, 5kg disc pair, 2 full RPT competition sets with Joe Rodriguez in Hudson Valley
 - o 2 pairs of 10kg RTP plates are in Queens with Frank Mintz
 - o 1 pair of 25kg plates and a Rogue bench are in Long Island with Chris Smith
 - 1 pair of 20kg plates are in Brooklyn with Kurt Roderick
- Had initial discussion about what to do with all of the equipment, plan is to sell all barbells, plates, and competition collars at a later date. Discussion will be continued.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023

- The meet sold out in 40 days.
- Waitlist invitations are set up via BARS, schedule is currently being worked on.
- James presented an overview of current finances & budget for 2023 States.
- Discussion of distribution of staff/TO hotel rooms:
 - Tier 1: fully comped rooms for event staff there for whole weekend, plus significant work before & after meet
 - Tier 2: discounted room rate for TOs that sign up to work 4-6 sessions across the weekend ahead of meet
 - Tier 3: reimbursement of discounted room rate for TOs that have already purchased a room and then help out an excessive amount, at meet director's discretion

NY WSO – Record of E-Vote, Week Commencing: June 26, 2023.
